To increase confidentiality, the CoachMic is available with digital encryption, compatible with Shure Axient® Digital receivers.

The CoachMic is light weight and small in size, and comes with an impact resistant, hard nylon case, resulting in reduced risk of damage to the transmitter and your production.

The nylon case is not only rugged, but also very light weight, making the CoachMic extremely comfortable to wear.

Armed with a dual direction mounting clip that allows the pack to be worn on the left or right side of the body in either a horizontal or vertical position, this transmitter is rugged, unobtrusive and very easy to use.

Remote control functionality allows monitoring and complete over-ride control of all transmitter settings using the [MicCommander™](#).

The functions of the CoachMic can be adjusted within a range of at least of 150ft (45m). This capability enables audio technicians to turn the transmitter on/off and make on-the-fly adjustments to frequency and audio levels in real time; without ever touching the transmitter.

Putting the transmitter in standby mode remotely during idle periods greatly extends the typical battery life, with no need to have contact with the wearer.
